




On arrival in Madrid you will be met and taken on a 3 hour guided tour of the city.

Following your tour you will check into your hotel, Hotel Santo Domingo (or similar) which will be home for the next two nights on a bed & breakfast basis.

Madrid, the capital of Spain, is a cosmopolitan city that combines the most modern infrastructures and the status as an economic, financial, administrative and service centre, with a large cultural and artistic heritage, a legacy of centuries of exciting history.

Today is at your leisure.

Why not explore The Museo del Prado, which is one of the most popular tourist attractions in Madrid. The 18th century structure designed by architect Juan de Villanueva houses one of the world's finest art collections.

Enjoy art and markets at Matadero Madrid or try food from around the globe at Mercado de Vallehermoso.

After breakfast take a fast train to the Spanish seaside resort town of San Sebastian.

On arrival you will be taken on a 3 hour guided tour of the city, taking in the Parte Vieja, City Hall, the Romantic center and more. Following the tour you will check into the Hotel Mercure (or similar) where you will stay for one night on a bed and breakfast basis.

While many visitors come for the beaches, arts celebrations and fiestas, San Sebastian-Donostia is serious about its food and drink. The Old Quarter's narrow, winding streets are full of bars and restaurants, and in the modern city, sidewalk cafes are all around.



This evening there will be a meal for the whole group in a Tapas restaurant in the old town.

This morning transfer across the border into France, which is approximately 20kms from San Sebastian.

There will be a 1 hour stop in fashionable Biarritz for morning tea.

Biarritz is half ritzy coastal resort, half summer surfers' hang-out. The seaside resort has been a favourite beach getaway since Napoléon III and his Spanish-born wife Eugénie arrived during the mid-19th century.

After your stop in Biarritz, continue to Bordeaux where you will arrive in time for lunch (own expense).

On arrival, check into the Hotel Mercure (or similar) for your 2 night stay on a bed and breakfast basis.

You'll be raising your glass many times in Bordeaux, which is renowned for its wines, considered amongst the best in the world. As the capital of the department Gironde in the region Aquitaine, it has one million inhabitants in its metropolitan area at a 2008 estimate. After years of neglect, the former wet docks are the country's new hot spot, with a number of cafés, gardens, and museums springing up all the time. The cultural, artistic, and music scenes are very vibrant.

Today there will be a full day tour of the UNESCO world heritage town St- Emilion. During the day there will be a visit to a chateau which will include wine tasting and lunch.



Today is at leisure to enjoy the many bars and restaurants of Bordeaux.

In the afternoon fly to Manchester.

On arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel, the Doubletree Hilton (or similar) where you will stay for the next 3 nights on a bed & breakfast basis.

Youthful, diverse, energetic and bursting with character; Manchester is one of the most exciting places to visit in the UK right now where everybody and anybody is very warmly welcomed. Known throughout the world as the birthplace of the industrial revolution, Manchester has a proud history in science, politics, music, arts and sport.

Today there will be a guided tour of the city. You may also like to visit to Manchester United.

Manchester United are the most successful club in the history of the Premier League and one of the biggest teams in world football.

Transfer by coach to the University of Bolton Stadium to watch the first test.

In the afternoon return to Edinburgh.

Transfer via the Lake District to the ancient walled city of York.

A magnificent circuit of 13th-century walls encloses a medieval spider's web of narrow streets. At its heart lies the immense, awe-inspiring York Minster, one of the most beautiful Gothic cathedrals in the world.

On arrival check into the Hilton York (or similar) where you will stay for the next two nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

Today is at your leisure to enjoy the many attractions of York.

Majesty of the iconic York Minster, marvel at masterpieces at York Art Gallery, experience the thunder of galloping hooves at York Racecourse or discover the city's grisly past at the York Dungeon, there is something for everyone in York.



After breakfast depart York for your 1 hour journey to Leeds.

Just an hour south of the southern Dales and one of the fastest-growing cities in the UK, Leeds is the glitzy embodiment of rediscovered northern self-confidence.

On arrival check in The Hilton Leeds (or similar) for your two night stay on a bed and breakfast basis.

Transfer by coach to Elland Road for today's second test.

**Test 2 :****Kangaroos vs Great Britain Lions.**

Depart Leeds for Cheltenham and check into Doubletree by Hilton (or similar) where you will be based for the next two nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

Afternoon is at your leisure.

Full day sightseeing to include lunch in a Cotswolds pub.

The Cotswolds are an area in south central and south west England comprising the Cotswold Hills, a range of rolling hills that rise from the meadows of the upper Thames to an escarpment, known as the Cotswolds Edge, above the Severn Valley and Evesham Vale. The area is defined by the bedrock of Jurassic limestone that creates a type of grassland habitat rare in the UK and that is quarried for the golden-coloured Cotswold stone.

Transfer to England's most beautiful city Bath, where you will stay for two nights at the Abbey Hotel (or similar) on a bed and breakfast basis.

On arrival there will be a tour to include the Roman Bath House.

Beautiful Bath has been a wellbeing destination since Roman times. The waters are still a big draw with both at the ancient Roman Baths and the thoroughly modern Thermae Bath Spa, which houses the only natural thermal hot springs in Britain you can bathe in.

Bath is a compact and visitor-friendly centre which is overflowing with places to eat and drink, plus some of the finest independent shops in Britain, making it the ideal city break. Immerse yourself in Bath's remarkable collection of museums and galleries, and enjoy year-round festivals, theatre, music and sports.

**Tour Prices:** Tour prices are based on costs in effect at **February 2020**. Costs will also depend on availability of all services/inclusions quoted on at time of booking. These costs are subject to the group travelling together throughout the tour. Any variation will incur an amendment fee and may also jeopardise the costs for the rest of the group. Prices are based on the tour numbers stipulated on the itinerary. Any change in tour numbers will result in a revised tour price. *Please note there may be specialised inclusions in your tour such as train tickets, show or match tickets, instant purchase airline tickets etc that are non-refundable in addition to the above cancellation charges. These cancellation fees are in addition to any cancellation fees that may be levied by our tour suppliers.*

Amendment Fee: Any person wishing to amend from the group tour arrangements will be charged a \$200.00 amendment fee per person plus any additional charges involved with the amendment (increase in airfare, additional transfers, accommodation etc).

Documentation: Australian citizens require a passport with minimum 6 months validity from date of departure from final destination. Other passport holders may require additional documentation. Please check your applicable requirements with your Travel Consultant. A copy of each person's passport is required.

Baggage: Free baggage allowance one piece weighing maximum 20 kg plus 1 cabin bag (piece) of 115cm with a maximum weight of 5kg per person (please note these restrictions vary between airlines & depends on your destination). Luggage in excess of these limits will be charged for at the appropriate excess baggage rates. Baggage is the responsibility of the passenger at all times (Travel Insurance is strongly recommended).

Insurance Protection: We strongly recommend you have Travel Insurance. Policies are available from Gullivers Sport Travel. If you choose to be covered for Travel Insurance with an alternative provider such as a credit card company, we recommend that you thoroughly check the policy wording for levels of coverage. Please ensure you are given a policy number and your policy includes 24hr emergency contact and assistance during your holiday.

Airline & Airport Taxes, Surcharges & Levies: Are not included in the tour cost as they are continually changing. Any of these charges imposed by the airline will be notified to you at the time of final payment 2 months prior to departure.

Frequent flyer/mileage accrual: Some group airfares are not eligible to accrue frequent flyer points (due to discounted group airfares).
